Rule 3358:5-11-12 | Responsible use of technology policy.
...of personally identifiable information (**PII**) on a workstation, USB druve, CD/DVD, or media other than a network drive. (E) Failure to comply (1) Violation of any of the Clark state responsible use of technology policies and procedures may result in disciplinary action. (2) Violators of these regulations may be ejected from Clark State owned or controlled property and subject to criminal prosecution and/or college ...
